

SONG SAA A GEM IN CAMBODIA'S KOH RONG ARCHIPELAGO

Temples, a tumultuous history and a modern-day economic renaissance: Cambodia may be famed for many things, but a gem that has remained little known in the kingdom is the private island paradise of Song Saa. Khmer for The Sweethearts Song Saa, the only private island resort in Cambodia, has made waves by redefining the notion of luxury. Priding itself on the finer points of taste and elegance — from the glass of prosecco on the boat ride to the island and the gorgeous kramas worn by staff, to the little notes on the villa door with a preview of what to expect at dinner, Song Saa pampers without being obtrusive. Instead, this exclusive sanctuary is synonymous with easy, unpretentious luxury (read: walking barefoot



to dinner, or any other part of the resort, for that matter, is not frowned upon).

Song Saa is home to 27 luxury villas built from sustainable materials and in perfect harmony with the natural environment. Each Overwater, Ocean or Jungle Villa is complete with a private pool and all forms of creature comforts such as high-speed WIFI connection or satellite TV. In the privacy of their plush accommodations, guests can shower looking out over the ocean, sip ocktails while watching the sun set from their private deck or have the resort's chef treat you and your guests to fresh seafood under the stars — with your feet dipped in the warm water of your private pool.

The Spa & Wellness Sanctuary with a Yoga & Meditation Centre lie on the eastern shore, designed to authentically showcase the surrounding archipelago, its staggering scenery and traditional remedies. A signature treatment like the Karuna Kaya Massage, with deep and rhythmic body work for realignment and softening of the muscular system and stimulation of energy flow, is, for example, held in an outdoor sala. Surrounded by the lush flora of the jungle, with the soothing sound of the waves as your only soundtrack, guests may draw energy from the natural surroundings for inner peace.

There are direct daily flights from Singapore to the main Cambodian airports of Siem Reap and Phnom Penh. Sihanoukville is a 50-minute flight from Siem Reap or a 3-hour drive from Phnom Penh, and private car transfers can be arranged for US\$150 each way. Song Saa is a 30-minute private speedboat ride from the coastal city of Sihanoukville. Private helicopter transfers from Siem Reap and Phnom Penh are also available.

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
