Song Saa Private Island

Song Saa Private Island, billed as the only private island resort in Cambodia, was founded three years ago and has received several accolades.

It was listed among lifestyle magazine Tatler's 101 Best Hotels in the World in 2013 and was also named as one of the Best Hotels in the World by travel guide Fodor's last year.

The resort is spread over two islands – one is 3.5ha wide and the other 5ha wide – in the Koh Rong Archipelago.

To get there from Phnom Penh Airport, take a three-and-a-half-hour car transfer provided by the private island to Sihanoukville Port. From there, a speedboat will take guests to the private island in 30 minutes.
