GREEN NOTES An abundance of local salvaged and recycled materials have been used throughout this resort, including wood from old fishing boats, timber from disused buildings, and driftwood from the island beaches. The hotel has created Cambodia's first marine reserve and also provides employment, educational and healthcare support for the island's 2,500 inhabitants.

STYLE NOTES Locally handmade furniture, Ploh linen and special features – including a glass floor so that the reef fish can be observed darting beneath villas perched on stilts over the sea – create a haven that promises 'luxury with a light touch'.
