**Ceylon Tea Trails, Hill Country, Sri Lanka**





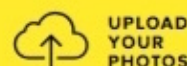

Partake in cups of fragrant local tea before roaming the rustic surrounds and visiting nearby tea estates, ravines, and waterfalls – trekking within this plantation offers jaw-dropping views of the lakes. After that, refresh yourselves with a dip in swimming pools fed by mountain springs and an aromatherapy bath.

## Amanoi, Ninh Thuan Province, Vietnam

Luxurious Vietnamese stay [Amanoi](#) lucked out with its breathtaking natural setting: its slate pagodas peek out from lush green hillsides, a marine reserve to one side, Núi Chúa National Park on the other. The hotel's clifftop perch ensures a sweeping view from most rooms. Settling on a particularly scenic vista could prove tricky; our closely contested favourites are the Ocean Pool Pavilions, which overlook both the East Sea and the Cliff Pool. Feast on local fishermen's daily catches and authentic Vietnamese dishes at the elegant central pavilion, while admiring Vinh Hy Bay's natural treasures, before exploring the Núi Chúa National Park. Sun-worshippers have many places to lay out their beach towels, but it's worth sacrificing an even tan to swim alongside shoals of tropical fish weaving through rainbow coral forests.

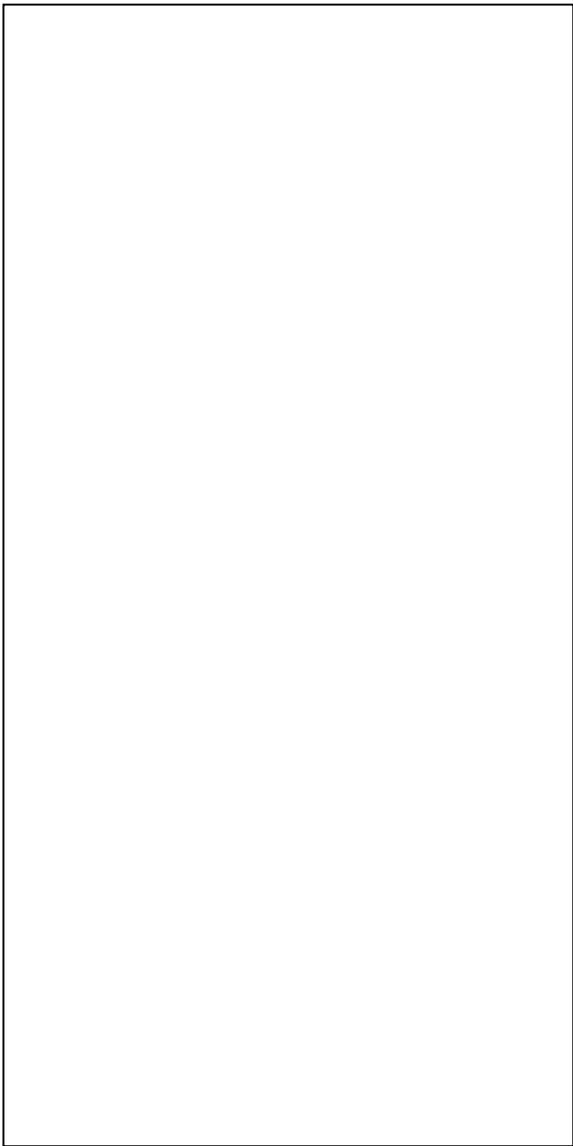
